Glashaboy Flood Relief Scheme – Overnight works

I am writing to provide you with an important update and information about the necessary overnight works that will be taking place within Hazelwood Shopping Centre over the coming weeks.

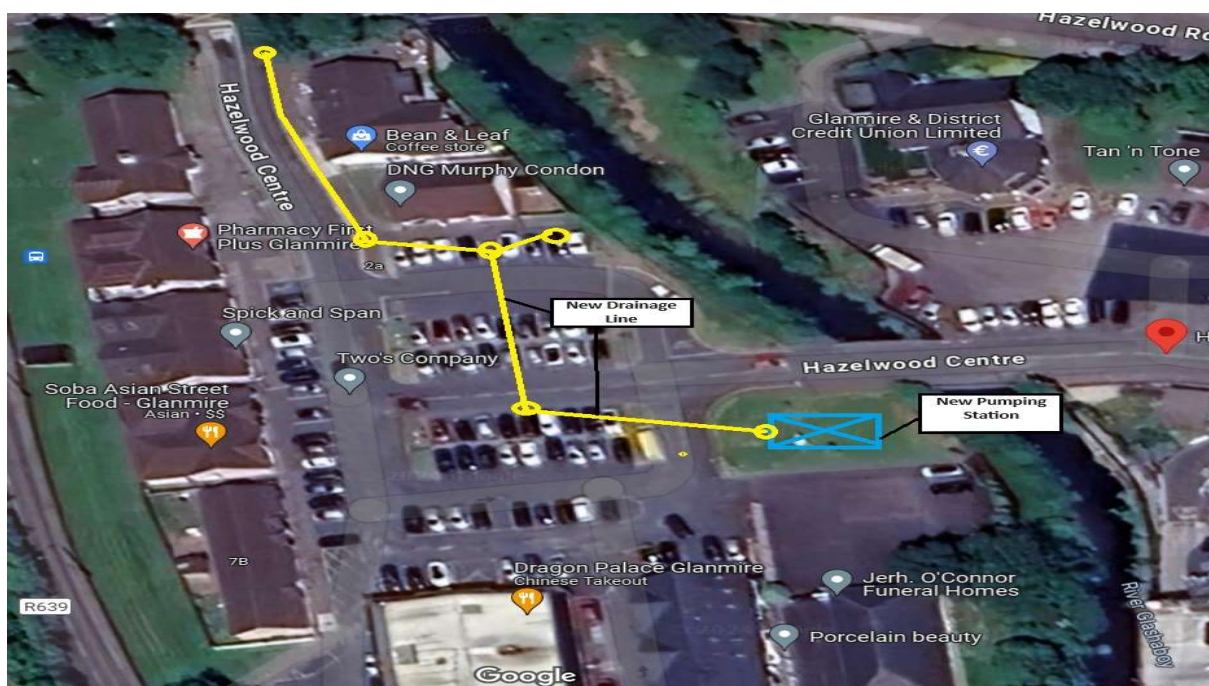
The purpose of these overnight works is to install new drainage (Shown in Yellow) within Hazelwood SC, commencing outside O'Connor's Funeral Home and working towards Bean & Leaf. This drainage will tie into the new pumping station once it is constructed in the coming months. (Shown in Blue)

We have carefully scheduled these works during nighttime hours to minimise disruption to businesses and patrons within the Hazelwood SC.

Here are some key details regarding the overnight works:

- Work will commence on **Monday the 8th of April**.
- Work will be carried out between the hours of **7pm to 7am, Monday to Friday**
- This will take approximately 4 weeks to complete.
- Work will commence outside O'Connor's Funeral Home and continue towards Bean and Leaf
- During this time, you can expect to see/hear equipment in operation, construction noise and lighting towers for additional light during the night hours.
- While we strive to minimise disruption, there may be some unavoidable inconvenience caused by the noise, and there will be restricted access to certain areas.
- **Access to businesses trading during these hours, will be maintained at all times.**
- The works area will be fenced off safely and securely during the hours of 7am – 7pm to ensure the safety of everyone on site.
